For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior members. Horses not to have won a total of 125 points.

4 Double Clears to qualify for the KBIS British Novice Second Rounds

Two sets of prize money will be awarded. Horses may only compete in one section. Competitors must declare which section at entry.

### **Class 2 Senior Discovery Championship First Round /1m Open PRE ENTRY & DRAWN ORDER Single Phase.**

Rules 314 and 287 will apply. Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members

For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6

For all horses born on or after 1 January 2011, irrespective of Points Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314c6

Two sets of prize money will be awarded. Horses may only compete in one section. Competitors must declare which section at entry.

Prizes £30, £25, £20, £15, £12 Entry Fee £12

**Entries will be limited to first 30.**

### **Class 3 1.10m Open/Equestrian Clearance Senior Newcomers First Round – PRE ENTRY & DRAWN ORDER**

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

**In the event of thirty or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may only compete in one section. Competitors must declare which section at entry.**

### **Class 4 1.20m Open Incorporating the Horse and Hound Foxhunter First Round – PRE ENTRY & DRAWN ORDER**

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

**Foxhunter Section:** Rule 310 and Rule 76.6 Apply. For Registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6 For all registered horses born on or after 1st January 2008 (for competitions held in 2015) irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear

qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Horse & Hound Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

**In the event of thirty or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may only compete in one section. Competitors must declare which section at entry.**

British Showjumping Scottish Branch Adult South West Open Championship to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Associate members. Silver League riders that have not jumped 4 classes 1.35m and above can compete in this class and not move up to the Gold League until a 5th class at 1.35m or above had been jumped from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

### **RULES**

1. All competitors will be judged under British Showjumping rules.
2. Substitution entries - see rule 79-3, refunds as per 79-4.
3. Prize money- British Showjumping rule 76-6 shall apply.
4. Horse boxes must not be mucked out on parking areas.
5. SAFETY-The Organising Committee has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of show officials.
6. Rule 82.20 No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as Owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in Any show jumping competition, without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
7. Objections must be made to the show secretary in accordance with British Showjumping rule 198-3.
8. Owners entering their horses do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches to the Show Committee in any respect whatsoever.
9. Entries confined to registered horses ridden by members in accordance with British Showjumping rule 79 or the British Showjumping 'Ticket to Ride' system.
