Class 952	Mature Cheddar	any cheddar cheese produced after 1 st July 2014
Class 953	Extra Mature Cheddar	any cheddar cheese produced before 1 st August 2014
Class 954	Farmhouse Cheddar	any cheddar cheese produced by a Farmhouse producer
Class 955	Speciality Cheese Soft White	
Class 956	Speciality Cheese Hard(includes territorials/reduced fats)	
Class 957	Speciality Cheese Blue - any blue cheese variety	
Class 958	Speciality Cheese – flavour added(eg fruit/nuts/herbs)	
Class 959	Best Scottish Cheese – automatic entry for all Scottish cheeses.	NO ENTRY FEE
Class 960	Peoples Choice – this class is automatically entered.	NO ENTRY FEE

DUMFRIES SHOW FOOD FESTIVAL

Regulations

1. All exhibits must be delivered to the Show and staged between MID-DAY and 5:00pm on Friday 4th August
2. No cheese exhibited must have been ironed more than once or it will be disqualified.
3. Exhibitors must state upon their Entry Forms whether they will unpack their cheeses on arrival or if they desire the officers of the Dumfries Agricultural Show to do so.
4. Judging will take place at 10:00am on Saturday 5th August. The Judge's decision will be final
5. All exhibits will remain on display until the show closes at 5:00pm on Saturday 5th August after which time all exhibits will be disposed of by the show committee in accordance with EEC regulations
6. Prize money will be posted to the winners within 4 weeks of the show.
7. The Dumfries Agricultural Show reserve the sole and absolute right to interpret these or any other prescribed regulations, conditions and prize lists, and to finally settle and determine all or any matters, questions, difference in regard there to or otherwise arising out of, or in connection with the Show and to substitute judges for those announced in the prize list, or to make additional appointments as may be deemed necessary.
8. Responsibility. Neither the Dumfries Agricultural Show nor any of its Officers or Servants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for anything that may happen from any cause or circumstance whatever to Exhibitors or their Servants or to any exhibited or property brought into the Showground; or otherwise for anything else in connection with, or arising out of attributable to, the show, or these or any other condition or regulation prescribed by the Dumfries Agricultural Show in relation thereto; each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to, or occasioned by or arising from any article exhibited by him and shall indemnify the Dumfries Agricultural Show against all legal and other proceedings in regard hereto.
9. All exhibitors and other persons admitted to the Showground shall be subject to rules, orders, regulations (including Health and Safety) of the Dumfries Agricultural Show.
